- B. Following the examples in the book of Acts. (Acts 8:35-36; 9:18; 10:43-48; 16:33)

IV. Where should you be baptized?

- A. In the presence of believers. (Acts 2:41)
- B. As a picture of the Gospel. (Matt. 28:18-20)

V. How should you be baptized?

- A. By immersion. (Matt. 3:13-16; Mk. 1:9-10; Jn. 3:23)
- B. As a picture of the Gospel. (Rom. 6:3-6)

V. Why should you be baptized?

- A. As a means of identification with the church. (Acts 2:41)
- B. As a means of identification to the lost. (Matt. 10:32)
- C. As a means of identification with Christ. (Col. 2:12; Matt. 3:13; Matt. 28:19)
