

THE RIGHT TO WORK Col 3:22-4:1; Titus 2:6-10

Work is a blessing not a curse.

- Work itself is **inherently good**.
- Your work is **important**; it **matters**.
- There's no such thing as "**secular**" or "**sacred**" work.
- You should do your work in a way that **honors God**.

How can I truly glorify God in my work?

1. See my work as **significant**. (Proverbs 14:23)
2. See my work as **sacred**. (Col. 3:23)
3. See my work as the place I am **sent**. (Col. 3:24b) What is your workstyle?

Titus 2:9-10 - *Exhort bondservants to be obedient to their own masters, to be well pleasing in all things, not answering back, 10 not pilfering, but showing all good fidelity, that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in all things.*

Key thought: We go to work for the same reason we go to worship; **to declare God's glory** and to serve.

If we do not see ourselves as significant, sacred, sent servants of the Lord Jesus then our **light goes out**.

- You are the **only Bible** that most people read.
- You are the **only reflection** of Jesus that most people will see.
- You are **plan A** for the evangelization of Central Iowa.
