Sermon: 1Corinthians 7:10-16

The believer is to understand and uphold the holiness and permanence of marriage.

We see that:

- 1. It is God's command that marriage is for life. (v.10, 11)
- 2. This is true even in marriages where one spouse becomes a believer, except if the unbeliever departs. (v. 12, 13, 15)
- Such marriages too are holy and may be used by the Lord to bring salvation to the unbelieving spouse. (v. 14, 16)

The church is called to be a confessing church, that she may be, the pillar and ground of the truth (1Tim. 3:15,16)

The Westminster Confession of Faith

Chapter 24—Of Marriage and Divorce

WCF 24.3 It is lawful for all sorts of people to marry, who are able with judgment to give their consent.(1) Yet it is the duty of Christians to marry only in the Lord.(2) And therefore such as profess the true reformed religion should not marry with infidels, papists, or other idolaters: neither should such as are godly be unequally yoked, by marrving with such as are notoriously wicked in their life, or maintain damnable heresies.(3)

WCF 24.5 Adultery or fornication committed after a contract, being detected before marriage, giveth just occasion to the innocent party to dissolve that contract.(1) In the case of adultery after marriage, it is lawful for the innocent party to sue out a divorce:(2) and after the divorce, to marry another, as if the offending party were dead. (3) (1)Matt. 1:18-20(2)Matt. 5:31-32 (3)Matt. 19:9; Rom. 7:2-3

WCF 24.6 Although the corruption of man be such as is apt to study arguments unduly to put asunder those whom God hath joined together in marriage: yet, nothing but adultery, or such wilful desertion as can no way be remedied by the Church, or civil magistrate, is cause sufficient of dissolving the bond of marriage:(1) wherein, a public and orderly course of proceeding is to be observed; and the persons concerned in it not left to their own wills, and discretion, in their own case.(2)


