Main Point:

1. God wants you to intercede for others.

2. Intercessory prayer appeals to God's nature for its requests.

3. Intercessory prayer is to be bold, persistent, and humble.

4. You should intercede for others in this manner because it works.

5. It works because of Christ's perfect intercession for you.
