Application Questions

- 1. Read **Acts 15:36-41**. After hearing this sermon, describe how the "separation" of these missionaries can be understood as a non-sinful and even wise solution to the "sharp disagreement" Paul and Barnabas experienced?
- 2. Read **Galatians 5:14-15**. While Paul was uncompromisingly fighting for the truth of the gospel in Galatia, there was lots of unnecessary conflict in the churches to which he was writing. What does this "biting" usually look like and what do you imagine Paul had in mind when he envisioned the threat of them "consuming" each other?
- 3. Read **1 Peter 4:13-15** & **Proverbs 26:20-21**. What conflicts have you had with other Christians that you thought at the time were like the one in Acts 15:36-41, but in retrospect you realize arose from your own sin?
- 4. Read **1 Corinthians 4:1-5**. In what situations have you failed to consider your stewardship before God, sacrificing the wisest and most fruitful path because you were trying to avoid conflict or disagreement?
- 5. Read **James 3:13-18**. What aspect of this great text is most needed in your life right now as you consider constructive solutions to the conflicts that you currently have or anticipate having in this season of your life?
