Grown-Ups In The Room Pt.15: "It's The Least We Can Do!"

I Text:

Old Covenant: *Isaiah 53*

New Covenant: *1Peter 2:21-25*

II Doctrine: Jesus Christ was an example for us in the way he handled persecution. The King of the universe accepted the persecution of this world to achieve a higher goal. He accepted the hate he received without becoming hateful. He absorbed the attacks of the world without becoming worldly. He trusted the plan of his Father in heaven for the redemption of his people. The Messiah bore the punishment of death we deserved, to give life to us who believe on him. We were all born in a state of rebellion and hatred towards God. The great Shepherd has brought us back to God the Father to live righteous lives, defined by the Bible.

III Comparing Scripture With Scripture:

1) Jesus Christ was an example for us in the way he handled persecution. The King of the universe accepted the persecution of this world to achieve a higher goal. (*1Peter 2:21, Isaiah 53:1-3*)

2) He accepted the hate he received without becoming hateful. He absorbed the attacks of the world without becoming worldly. He trusted the plan of his Father in heaven for the redemption of his people. (*1Peter 2:22,23; Isaiah 53:4-8*)

3)The Messiah bore the punishment of death we deserved, to give life to us who believe on him. We were all born in a state of rebellion and hatred towards God. The great Shepherd has brought us back to God the Father to live righteous lives, defined by the Bible. (*1Peter 2:24,25; Isaiah 53:9-12*)

21For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: 22Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: 23Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed [himself] to him that judgeth righteously: 24Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. 25For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.
