An account was given during the *Siege of Ladysmith* of a British civilian who was arrested, tried by a military court, and given a year in prison for being a *discourager*! The townspeople and its defending garrison were at a difficult point. Rather than standing strong, fighting with them, and thereby *strengthening and encouraging* the men who were battling for their lives, he put *faintness* into their hearts through his words and actions. The court viewed him as an enemy. Not so of the Apostle Paul and the Son of Encouragement! *Faithful* are those who strengthen and encourage!
