God's Creation Ex Nihilo—out of nothing

Genesis 1:1-3

- 1. Genesis 1:1 in light of Israel's recent exodus
 - a. There was God existing, not gods
 - b. God, not gods, made universe & earth
 - c. Later revelation of Jesus (John 1:1-3; Col 1:16)
 - d. Let us read Gen 1:1 in light of worldly brainwashing
- 2. Four understandings of the syntax of Gen 1:1-3
 - a. "...when God created..., the earth was without form..."
 - b. "In the beginning when God created (v.2), God said..."
 - c. Gen 1:1 is a title, summarizing vv. 2-31
 - d. Gen 1:1 is God's first miracle; vv. 2-31 describe creation
- 3. Creation ex nihilo-out of nothing
 - a. God always the subject of verb "create"—man (Gen 1:27), animals (Ps 104:30), sea creatures (Gen 1:21), mountains (Amos 4:13; cf. Num 16:30; Isa 65:17)
 - b. God also "creates" from what already exists (Israel in Isa 43:15).
- 4. Elohim as Trinity at creation
 - a. Not Yahweh but everyone's God
 - b. Father working through the Son (Col 1:16)
 - c. Spirit "moving" over creation—creating energy
- 5. Observations
 - a. Our worldview depends on Genesis
 - b. Rejecting Genesis is tantamount to rejecting Christ!
 - c. God also speaks Light into our dark lives (2 Cor 4:6; cf. John 8:12; 9:5)
