6b Violence covereth the mouth of the wicked.  
7b The name of the wicked shall rot.  
8b A prating fool shall fall.  
9b He that perverteth his ways shall be known.  
10 He that winketh with the eye causeth sorrow: But a prating fool shall fall.  
11b Violence covereth the mouth of the wicked.  
12a Hatred stirreth up strifes:  
13b A rod is for the back of him that is void of understanding.  
14b The mouth of the foolish is near destruction.  
15b The destruction of the poor is their poverty.  
16b The fruit of the wicked to sin.  
17b He that refuseth reproof erreth.  
18 He that hideth hatred with lying lips, And he that uttereth a slander, is a fool.  
19a In the multitude of words there wanteth not sin:
