

The Death of Abraham

Genesis 25:1-11

Main Point:

Prepare for your death by passing on God's covenant to the children of the church.

1. Like Abraham, you will not be here forever.

2. Before you die, you should pass on God's covenant to the next generation.

3. God will ordinarily bless your efforts because the children of believers are part of the covenant community.

4. Prepare for your death by passing on God's covenant to the children of the church.

Genesis 17:19 "... Sarah your wife shall bear you a son, and you shall call his name Isaac; I will establish My covenant with him for an everlasting covenant ... (NKJV)

Psalms 71:18 ¹⁸ Now also when *I am* old and grayheaded, O God, do not forsake me, Until I declare Your strength to *this* generation, Your power to everyone *who* is to come. (NKJV)

1 Corinthians 7:14 ¹⁴ For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband; otherwise your children would be unclean, but now they are holy. (NKJV)
