A Foreign Widow's Mission

1 Kings 17:7-24

I. THE PROVIDENCE OF GOD

- **A.** "<u>I Have Commanded</u>" (vs. 4, 9)—God is the Almighty Sovereign
 - 1. God <u>already</u> has a plan.
 - 2. He has the power to make it happen.
 - 3. We don't have to *know* God's plan for it to work.
- **B.** "<u>Don't Be Afraid</u>" (v. 13-14)—God's providence provides the basis for great confidence.
 - 1. Fear is characteristic of the <u>human condition</u> since the Fall of Eden.
 - 2. God understands our fear and has *compassion* on us.
 - 3. God <u>reassures</u> us with the promise of His help.
- **C.** <u>**Daily Bread**</u> (v. 14; Ex 16:35; Mt 6:11, 31-32)—It's about relationship.
 - 1. God's resources are inexhaustible.
 - 2. God's care is faithful, hands-on and involved.
 - 3. You can't hoard manna but must trust God daily to deliver it.

II. THE CHARACTER OF GOD

- A. The <u>Compassion</u> of God (Deut 10:18; Ps 146:9)
 - 1. For <u>Widows</u> and the <u>Fatherless</u> (Ex 22:22; Ps 68:5; Js 1:27)
 - **2. For <u>Foreigners</u>** (Ex 22:21; Jer 49:11; Lk 4:25-27; Jn 10:16)
- **B.** The <u>Humility</u> of God (vs. 10-11; Lk 4:25-26; Jn 4:7)—*Asking* for help in order to *bring* help
 - 1. The people *we need* to help <u>us</u> are the ones we are also *sent* to bless.
 - 2. Our weakness makes our witness accessible.

III. THE WIDOW OF ZAREPHATH

A. <u>Her Faith</u>

- 1. She <u>recognizes</u> and <u>honors</u> Elijah as a prophet of the LORD. (v. 12, 14)
- **2.** She <u>believes</u> and <u>obeys</u> the word of the LORD (v. 15; Ps 9:9-10)—Giving <u>first</u> is a declaration of faith
- **B.** <u>Her Fear</u> (vs. 12-15, 18)
 - 1. There won't be <u>enough</u> left for me and my family. (Mal 3:10; Phil 4 :19)
 - My sin has <u>ruined</u> my life. (If it were not for Jesus, this would be true!)
 - 3. God is <u>out to get</u> me.

IV. THE MYSTERIOUS METHODS OF GOD

- A. <u>God Sends Crises</u>. (Is 45:7)
 - 1. The <u>Drought</u> of the Land (natural or economic conditions)
 - 2. The <u>Death</u> of a Loved One (personal, relational tragedy)
 - 3. A Guilty Conscience (the problem of sin)
- B. God Reveals Himself in Crises. (Jn 11:14-15, 40, 45)
 - 1. The Reality of our Situation
 - 2. The <u>Glory</u> of God
 - 3. So we might <u>Believe</u> in Him
- **C.** <u>God Pursues Us</u>. (vs. 12, 24) *He Loves us and wants relationship.*

Because the LORD is our God, we don't have to be afraid of anything that might happen!
