I. Revelation - "by revelation of Jesus Christ"(vs. 11-12) Grace that is:
A. Divine - "the gospel...preached of me is not of man"
B. Delivered -"neither received it of man"
C. Doctrinal - "neither was I taught it"
II. Redemption - "called me by His grace" (vs. 13-17)

Grace that changes our:
A. Behavior - "my conversation in time past"
B. Boast - "it pleased God who ....called me by His grace"
C. Belief -"reveal His Son in me that I might preach Him"
III. Relationships - "of the apostles saw I none" (vs. 8-10)

Grace that leads us to:
A. Refute - "went up to Jerusalem to see Peter"
B. Refresh - "saw I none, save James the Lord's brother"
C. Rejoice - "they glorified God in me"
