

## "The Spiritual Journey"

By the Grace of God Galatians 1:11-24

### Experiencing His grace through:

- I. Revelation "by revelation of Jesus Christ" (vs. 11-12)

  Grace that is:
  - A. Divine "the gospel...preached of me is not of man"
  - B. Delivered "neither received it of man"
  - C. Doctrinal "neither was I taught it"
- II. Redemption "called me by His grace" (vs. 13-17)

Grace that changes our:

- A. Behavior "my conversation in time past"
- B. Boast "it pleased God who....called me by His grace"
- C. Belief "reveal His Son in me that I might preach Him"
- III. Relationships "of the apostles saw I none" (vs. 8-10)

  Grace that leads us to:
  - A. Refute "went up to Jerusalem to see Peter"
  - B. Refresh "saw I none, save James the Lord's brother"
  - C. Rejoice "they glorified God in me"
