Your Federal Head—In Your Stead

I. God has had a people since before creation

- Eph 1:4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world...
- Eph 1:5 Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children...
- Eph 1:6 To the praise of the glory of his grace...
- Eph 1:11 In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:
- Rom 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate *to be* conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- Rom 8:30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

A. God gave His elect people to Christ in the Covenant of Grace before time began Joh 6:37 All that the Father giveth me shall come to me...

- Joh 6:39 And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of **all which he hath given me** I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.
- Mat 1:21 ...thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.
- Isa 53:8 ... for the transgression of my people was he stricken.
- Joh 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:
- Joh 10:28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish...

- Joh 10:29 My Father, which gave *them* me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to pluck *them* out of my Father's hand.
- Joh 17:2 As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him.
- Joh 17:6 ...thine they were, and thou gavest them me...
- Joh 17:9 I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for **them which thou hast given me**; for they are thine.
- Joh 17:24 Father, I will that they also, **whom thou hast given me**, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory...
- Heb 2:13 ...Behold I and the children which God hath given me.
- B. God even placed His elect children "In Christ"—All of salvation hinges on this
- 1Co 1:30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus...
- Eph 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly *places* in Christ:
- Eph 1:4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world...
- Eph 1:6 ... wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.
- Eph 1:7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins...
- Eph 1:11 **In whom** also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:
- 2Co 5:21 For he hath made him *to be* sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God **in him**.
- Rom 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus...
- II. Christ as your federal head—(You in Christ)—Is how you get eternal life

A. God's way of judgment—As in Adam—Even so in Christ

1Co 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

B. All who were "in Adam" receive sin, condemnation and death

- Rom 5:12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:
- Rom 5:18 ...by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation...
- Rom 5:19 ...by one man's disobedience many were made sinners...

C. All who were "in Christ" receive grace, justification and life

Rom 5:18 ...even so by the righteousness of one *the free gift came* upon all men unto justification of life.

Rom 5:19 ...so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous.

D. The action of the head counts for all who are in the head (no choice—no option)

- —This totally eliminates any idea of "decisional salvation"—(Not by our decisions)
- —The two decisions that mattered were Adam's decision to sin and God's to save

III. Christ in you is how you become spiritually alive

- Col 1:27 To whom God would make known what *is* the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is **Christ in you, the hope of glory**:
- Gal 4:6 ...God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.
- Joh 5:40 And ye will not come to me, that ye might have life.
- Joh 6:44 No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him...
- Joh 5:25 Verily, Verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live.
- Rom 9:16 So then *it is* not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but of God that sheweth mercy.

IV. The idea of 'in the stead of' in the Bible

A. God provided a ram to die 'in the stead of' His child of the promise

Gen 22:8 And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb...

Gen 22:13 And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind *him* a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering **in the stead of** his son.

B. Judah offered himself 'in the stead of' his brother

- Gen 44:32 For thy servant became surety for the lad unto my father, saying, If I bring him not unto thee, then I shall bear the blame to my father for ever.
- Gen 44:33 Now therefore, I pray thee, let thy servant abide instead of the lad a bondman to my lord; and let the lad go up with his brethren.

C. Moses offered himself 'in the stead of' God's sinful children

Exo 32:32 Yet now, if thou wilt forgive their sin—; and if not, blot me, I pray thee, out of thy book which thou hast written.

D. Jesus died literally 'in the place of' a murderous thief named 'son of the father'

- Mar 15:15 And so Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged *him*, to be crucified.
- Mar 15:28 ...And he was numbered with the transgressors.

V. Your federal head 'in your stead' is how God is satisfied and you are justified

- Isa 53:3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were *our* faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.
- Isa 53:4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
- Isa 53:5 But he *was* wounded for our transgressions, *he was* bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.
- Isa 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.
- Isa 53:7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.
- Isa 53:8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.
- Isa 53:9 And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither *was any* deceit in his mouth.
- Isa 53:10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put *him* to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see *his* seed, he shall prolong *his* days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.
- Isa 53:11 He shall see of the travail of his soul, *and* shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.
- Isa 53:12 Therefore will I divide him *a portion* with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

VI. The eternal results of a justified people and a satisfied God

A. Justified

Rom 8:33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? *It is* God that justifieth.

Rom 5:9 ...being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

B. Reconciled

- 2Co 5:18 And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ...
- Rom 5:10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved...

VII. From Jesus 'in your place' to you in His place

Luk 23:43 And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise.
