### FIRST BIND THE STRONG MAN

Text: "How can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man? And then he will spoil his house" Mat. 12:29. Compare Luke 11:21-23.

Introduction: Notice here in Matthew 12 the natural condition of fallen man and the circumstances he is in:

- 1. A sinner with total inability verse 22.
- 2. Surrounded by blasphemy of the Pharisees verse 24.
- 3. Under the power of Satan and a member of his kingdom verse 26.
- 4. Needs to be under true evangelism verse 28.
- 5. And our text shows how God saves sinners verse 29.

#### I. WHO IS THE STRONG MAN?

- 1. The Devil powerful and mighty.
- 2. Serpent filled with devilish wisdom.
- 3. Satan one who captures his prey.
- 4. The god of this world governs his prey.
- 5. The prince of demons has power to hold his prey.
- 6. A roaring lion threatens and seeks to destroy God's people (1 Pet. 5:8).
- 7. An angel of light seeks to deceive God's people (2 Cor. 11:13-15).
- 8. The wolf catches and scatters the sheep, seeks to kill and destroy them; kills just for the sake of killing.
- References: Mat. 7:15; Acts 20:29-31.

## II. WHAT IS SATAN'S PALACE? Here we turn to the passage in Luke.

- 1. The corrupt heart of unregenerate man.
- 2. Where Satan dwells as a king.
- 3. Where Satan has set up his throne.
- 4. Where Satan keeps court.
- 5. Where Satan courtiers are.
- 6. Satan's palace is a filthy palace, perfectly agreeable to the nature of old Lucifer.
- 7. Satan's palace is kept by a guard of devils and worldly lusts (Luke 11:21-22).

### III. WHO IS THE STRONGER MAN?

- 1. He is Jesus the Son of God.
- 2. Jesus the God-man.
- 3. Christ the Redeemer.
- 4. Christ Jesus the Mighty God.
- 5. Jesus the Great Shepherd (1 Pet. 2:24-25).

# IV. HOW DOES CHRIST BIND SATAN, THE STRONG MAN? He binds Satan by performing seven wonderful things in the heart of a sinner:

- 1. By awakening the sinner.
- 2. By enlightening the sinner.
- 3. By regenerating the sinner.

- 4. By giving the sinner a holy heart.
- 5. By giving the sinner a holy nature.
- 6. By implanting the principles of grace and holiness in the heart.
- 7. By making the heart of man a fit habitation for God to dwell in (Ezek. 36:26-27).
- This disarms Satan and destroys his vile habitation. He has got to go!

## V. WHAT IS GOD'S PURPOSE FOR BINDING SATAN, THE STRONG MAN?

- 1. So the sinner's will can be freed (Psa. 110:3).
- 2. So the sinner can go free.
- 3. So the sinner can repent and believe the Gospel (Mark 1:14-15).

## VI. WHAT HAPPENS WHEN GOD SAVES A SINNER? Listen carefully!

- 1. The devil goes out.
- 2. Christ comes in.
- 3. The Holy Ghost comes in.
- 4. The Kingdom of God comes in.
- 5. The believer becomes a new creature in Christ Jesus.
- 6. The believer is no longer at war with God.
- 7. The believer is no longer on the devil's side.
- 8. Praise God, Christ meets Satan on his own ground and defeats him (Gen. 3:15).

## Conclusion: In salvation, Christ spoils:

- 1. Satan's goods
- 2. Satan's house
- 3. Satan's dwelling place
- 4. Satan's palace
- 5. Satan's throne.
- Let us read again very carefully Luke 11, verses 20 thru 23. Amen and Amen!
