Then when he was really afraid to face his brother on the way home, God showed Him mercy and it looked like he finally got his act together. Only to blow it again. Then this happens ...

Please use the devotional material below each day this week to meet with Jesus. Ask Christ to teach us His ways that we may walk in them to accomplish His purposes.

Sunday AM

READ Genesis 35:1-29; First John 5:19-21. DISCUSS, How did God pursue Jacob? How did Jacob respond? What is the connection between renewal and idols? Why? PRAY thanking God for His relentless pursuit of us.

Sunday PM

READ tonight's passage: **First Timothy 3:1-16**. DISCUSS, What is the mystery of Godliness? What are we supposed to do? PRAISE God for His gift to us in Christ.

Monday

READ **Genesis 35:1-4**. DISCUSS, How does God respond to Jacob's failure at Shechem (Ch. 34)? How does Christ show us this same mercy? PRAY for God to show us how Christ is absolutely trustworthy. Ask Him to show our neighbors this peace.

Tuesday

READ **Genesis 35:5-15**. DISCUSS, How did God provide for them on their way to Bethel? How does this reveal their lack of faith expressed in 34:30? Why does God show them such mercy? BEFRIEND someone today by trusting God's provision for you. PRAY, "Lord, forgive us for ways we trust our own efforts more than You. Teach us to trust You fully and completely."

Wednesday

READ Genesis 35:16-22. DISCUSS, Why do things like dying in childbirth and sexual assault continue to take place even among God's people in renewal? PRAY, Ask God to enable us to trust Him in difficult circumstances.

Thursday

READ **Genesis 34:23-29**. DISCUSS, In this family snapshot, what do we see of God's faithfulness? Given what we know about his family why is this remarkable? How is that true with us also? PRAY, "Jesus, empower us to love our families without compromising what You have called us to do."

Friday

READ Genesis 35:1-29; First John 5:19-21. DISCUSS, What has God been teaching from these passages this week? PRAY thanking the Lord for His faithfulness to us.

Saturday

PREPARE today for the gathered worship service tomorrow. Do what you can *today* so that you will be less rushed tomorrow.

READ **Genesis 36-37**. Come to worship tomorrow expecting to hear from God through His Word and to learn more about our God together. Pray for God's glory to be more and more manifested in the Woodstock area. Pray that He will use us to extend His grace as we celebrate it together.
