

Baptism and Revival

Acts 2:38

- We believe that baptism is an ordinance commanded by Jesus Christ and obeyed through the local church, and is the immersion of a believer into the water as a first step of faith, identifying the candidate with the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ and His church.

Mark 1:9; And it came to pass in those days, that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized of John in Jordan.

John 3:23: And John also was baptizing ... because there was much water there: and they came, and were baptized.”

1. Many Nations on the Day of Pentecost hearing & believing were baptized:

Acts 2:38; Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

2. The Samaritans hearing & believing were baptized:

Acts 8:12; And when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.

3. The Ethiopian Eunuch hearing & believing was baptized:

Acts 8:36-38; What doth hinder me to be baptized? And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God... and they went down both into the water, both Phillip and the eunuch; and he baptized him.

4. The Apostle Paul hearing & believing was baptized:

Acts 9:18; And immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales: and he received sight forthwith, and arose, and was baptized.

5. Cornelius and the Gentiles hearing & believing were baptized:

Acts 10:47,48; Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized, which have received the Holy Ghost as well as we? And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord.

6. Lydia and her household hearing & believing were baptized:

Acts 16:15; And when she was baptized, and her household...

7. The Jailer and his household hearing & believing were baptized:

Acts 16:33; And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed their stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straightway.

8. Crispus, his house, and many Corinthians, hearing & believing were baptized:
Acts 18:10; And Crispus, the chief ruler of the synagogue, believed on the Lord with all his house; and many of the Corinthians hearing believed, and were baptized.

9. The Ephesians hearing & believing were baptized:

Acts 19:5; When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.
