The Lord Has A Day; It's The 8<sup>th/</sup>1<sup>st</sup> Day; How Shall We Then Live? Objections:

Rom. 14:5,6 – Disputed Fast Days, not Lord's Day

Gal. 4:9-11 - Mosaic Law Whole Calendrical System not Paul's Appointed Day of Gathering

Col. 2:15-18 - Mosaic Law Whole Calendrical System not the Lord's Day

Trust Me! - The 4<sup>th&</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> Words: We honor the Lord and His representatives when we sanctify the Lord's Day

- 1. We sanctify the Lord's Day by honoring the 5<sup>th</sup> Commandment Lev. 19
- 2. We sanctify the Lord's Day by ceasing from most vocational and arduous labors. Ex. 16:23-29; 20:10; 31:14-15; 35:2; Lev. 23:3; Deut. 5:14; Jer. 17:21-27
- 3. We sanctify the Lord's Day by ceasing from commerce. Nehemiah 10:31; 13:15-22
- 4. We sanctify the Lord's Day by making preparations for it. Matt. 27:62; Mk. 15:42; 23:54; Jn. 19:31
- 5. We sanctify the Lord's Day by convocating with the Lord and His people. Lev. 23:1-3; Heb. 10:19-31;
- 6. We sanctify the Lord's Day by focusing on His Word. Isa. 58:13; Acts 13:27, 42, 44; 15:21; 16:13; 17:2; 18:4
- 7. We sanctify the Lord's Day by engaging in works of mercy. (Bilbo and the Dwarves) Ex. 20:10; 23:4-5; Deut. 5:14; 22:1-4; Mt. 12:1-13; Mk. 2:23-28; 3:1-5; Lk. 6:1-11; 13:10-17; 14:1-6; Jn. 5:1-15
- 8. We sanctify the Lord's Day by making it a day of celebration. Lev. 23:39; 24:5-9; Hos. 2:11 (Not Boiling Our Children In Its Milk)
- 9. We sanctify the Lord's Day by taking hands off our lives, trusting God for the (bright!) future.
- 10. We sanctify the Lord's Day by being a peculiar people. Ezekiel 20:1-27
