God's **development** in Moses' life.

God's ability to do the **impossible**.

The “why” of Moses' life is found in one word-**obedience**.

Partial obedience is **total** disobedience.

Total obedience is always met with resistance.

The Problem:

The **constricting** of Pharaoh's heart.

The **complaining** of the people of God.

The Plagues (Exodus 7-12):

There is no **rush** to judgment.

The judgment of God is **thorough**.

It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the **living God**.
