Examine the Scriptures (Be Berean!)

- Re: Context of the Feast of Booths: John 7
- Re: Condemnation -- Romans 8 (esp. Vv. 1, 34)
- To Prepare for Community Led Sunday Next Week: 1 Corinthians 12:8-1 Corinthians 12:10; Eph 4 (esp. 11-17)

Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

- What do we do with passages like this that are not in the oldest and best manuscripts? What would be over valuing the passage, and what undervaluing?
- Recount the preceding context of John 7
- Recall John's overall goal in writing the Gospel
- What goal did the scribes and Pharisees have in asking Jesus about the woman caught in adultery (see esp. v. 6)?
- Compare and contrast the scribes and Pharisees' response to Jesus with His invitation to them in 7:37.
- If you could have been their life coach, how would you coach them in regards to their approach to Jesus?
- Is Jesus soft on sin? If you conclude not, what then is He in regards to moral sins?
- Community Group Question: What does this passage reveal about Jesus in relation to the Law and sinners? How would this story argue that we as Christians should approach Law breakers?
