 - 1. The Biblical doctrine of the Trinity is revealed _____ and ___ in the Old and New Testaments (Genesis 1:1-3).
 - -God is a single being (Deuteronomy 6:4).
 - -At the same time, plurality within the Godhead is indicated in a number of ways.
 - •By the Use of Plural Pronouns (Genesis 1:26; 3:22)
 - •By the Use of Plural Verbs with Elohim (Genesis 20:13; 35:7)
 - •By the Repetition of God's Name to Distinguish Between God and God (Psalm 45:6, 7 with Hebrews 1:8-12; Psalm 110:1)
 - •By the Angel of the Lord (Genesis 16:7-13; 22:11-18; 31:11, 13; 48:15, 16; Exodus 3:1-4; Judges 13:20-23)
 - •By the Deity of the Messiah in the OT (Isaiah 7:14; 9:6)
 - •By God, the Word, and the Spirit as the Joint Causes of Creation and Providence (Psalm 33:6; Isaiah 61:1; 63:9-12; Haggai 2:4, 5)
 - -All three persons of the Trinity possess the attributes of God (<u>eternity</u>: Psalm 90:2; Micah 5:2; Hebrews 9:14; <u>omniscience</u>: 1 John 3:20; John 21:17; 1 Corinthians 2:10, 11; <u>omnipresence</u>: 1 kings 8:27; Matthew 28:20; Psalm 139:7-10; <u>indwelling</u>: 2 Corinthians 6:16; Colossians 1:27; John 14:17)
 - -All three persons of the Trinity perform the works of God (John 5:21; Romans 8:11).

 - -The Singularity of God (Is. 43:10; 44:6, 8; 45:5, 14, 18, 21, 22; 46:9; 47:8; John 17:3; 1 Corinthians 8:5, 6; Galatians 4:8, 9)
 - -The Deity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (<u>Father</u>: 1 Corinthians 8:6; Romans 1:7; 1 Corinthians 1:3; 2 Corinthians 1:2; Galatians 1:1; Ephesians 1:2; etc.; <u>Son</u>: John 1:1, 14; Colossians 2:9; <u>Holy Spirit</u>: Acts 5:3, 4; 2 Corinthians 3:17)
 - -The Distinctiveness of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Matt. 3:16, 17; John 5:23; 14:26; 15:26; Ephesians 2:18; Colossians 1:15)
