Inner Transformation

## Psalm 51:9-10

Three principles that prove biblical repentance desires more than the blessing of forgiveness.

David trusted God to not relate to him as his sins deserved and sought inner transformation that produced lasting change.

## Psalm 51:9

I. Biblical repentance trusts that God will not view the believer in light of his sin.

"It is not enough to ask for forgiveness; there must be a change of heart, a revitalized spirit, or the sinner will do it again."

## Psalm 51:10a

II. Biblical repentance is a complete transformation beginning with the inner person.

Be committed to pray for and wait for real heart change.

## Psalm 51:10b

III Biblical repentance desires sustained change.
