### I. Introduction and review: How can you increase your faith? v. 1

#### II. Pray. v. 2

- A. Humbly approach the LORD. Job 42:1-6
  - 1. Habakkuk's attitude has changed. No more arguments, excuses, or questioning of God's ways. 1:2,12 2:20
  - 2. Remember Who God is and who you are.
    - a. Do not compare yourself to other people. 1:13 Lu. 18:10-11
    - b. You have no claim on God. Lu. 18:12
  - 3. What should be the attitude of our nation? Our church?
- B. Fear and worship God.
  - 1. God alone is "Awesome".
  - 2. Praise God for Whom He is and what He does. Ro. 11:36 Acts 4:24f
  - 3. Fuel for praise may be found in the report of His deeds in Scripture. Ps. 44 78
- C. Ask for God to renew His work.
  - 1. Notice what Habakkuk does not ask.
  - 2. Pray for God to send revival in our day: church, nation, individual.
  - 3. Plead with God to remember His covenant and show mercy. 1:12 Luke 18:13-14 Dt. 30:1-3 Isa. 49:15 Lam. 3:32 Ex. 2:24 33:19 103:13.

#### III. Remember. v. 3-15

- A. Remembering God's attributes and acts is vital when your faith is tried. Ps. 77:11f
  - 1. Many of us struggle with doubt from time to time.
  - 2. Our faith rests of the realities of Who God is and what He does in space and time
  - 3. Your faith will be enriched as you reflect upon God's great deeds of the past.
- B. Habakkuk builds up faith by recalling God's great works. Zech. 9:14 Ps. 77:16f
  - 1. The vision recalls God's great work of deliverance in the Exodus and anticipates future deliverance from Babylon.
  - 2. God appears in awesome splendor and might. v. 3-7 2:14 Ex. 19:16f 5:3 Nah. 1:5 Ps. 68:7 8:1 97:4-5 Deut. 33:2 32:24 Ps. 90:2
  - 3. God saves His people and judges His enemies. v.8-15 Is. 66:15 34:1f 51:9-10 63:1f
- C. How does this vision of God help Habakkuk and the Jewish remnant? IICo. 4:18 5:7
  - 1. Just as God miraculously delivered His people out of Egypt, He will bring His people back from Babylon and establish them in the land. Deut. 33:2
  - 2. Just as God judged Pharaoh, He will crush the Babylonian oppressors. v.12b-15
  - 3. During the hard days of exile they must live by faith in these spiritual realities.
- D. How does Habakkuk's vision help us thousands of years later? Ps. 28:8
  - 1. We too gain comfort as we recall God's great works of faithfulness to His people.
  - 2. We have far more to remember than Habakkuk did.
    - a. Christ has come bringing salvation to His people and defeat to God's enemies.
    - b. Our Savior will come again bringing final deliverance and judgment as He establishes His righteous kingdom forever. Rev. 1:7 II Pe. 3:10
  - 3. Did Habakkuk realize he was pointing to the coming of Christ? v. 13,18 2:14 I Pe. 1:10-12 Ro. 1:2 3:21 Lu. 24:44f Re. 16:18-19 Zech. 14:4

## **IV.** Trust. v. 16-19

- A. Habakkuk is transformed from fear to faith.
  - 1. God's chastisement upon Israel makes him tremble. v. 16 Job 42
  - 2. He learns to rejoice in the LORD in spite of the worst of circumstances. v. 17-18 Zeph. 3:14f Phil. 4:4f Zech. 9:9 Isa. 66:10
  - 3. God is his strength. v. 19 Ps. 18:32-33 Ex. 15:2,13 Isa. 40:29-31
- B. You too can live above your circumstances by faith. Ps. 20:1 I John 5:4 4:18
  - 1. You will experience distress in this world. v. 16-17 John 16:33 II Ti. 3:12
  - 2. Instead of being overwhelmed by earthly circumstances, rejoice in your God and Savior. v. 18
  - 3. He will make you strong. v. 19
