### **Examine the Scriptures (Be Berean!)**

- Romans 6:15-23

### **Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)**

- Note the similar structure of Paul's question-answer writing in 6:1ff and 6:15ff. What is the difference between sin in verse 1 and sin in verse 15?
- What should we know (16-18) that if we knew it would make the answer to the question in verse 1 obvious?
- To what were you enslaved in the past and what was the result of that enslavement?
- What have you now become enslaved to and what is the result of that enslavement?
- Paul uses the language of presenting yourself and your members (16, 19) how do we do this; what did it look like in your day to day life before you were in Christ; how should that look like now that you have been joined to Christ?
- What is it going to take for you to obey Paul's command, "...now present your members as slaves to righteousness..."? What role can and should the body of Christ play in your "presenting"?
- What is the result of such a lifestyle where you present your members as slaves to righteousness? Is this lifestyle your lifestyle and is this sanctification evident in your life?
- In 20-23 Paul adds further grounds upon which his command stands. In your own words, what are those grounds, i.e., what good reasons does Paul give that you should present your members as slaves to righteousness?
- Based on what God has brought to you in and through your union with Christ Jesus, how should you live?
