The last four verses of Romans 8 form the pinnacle of the book, this section lifts our hearts to new heights in **understanding the Grace of God**. Paul poses **5 rhetorical questions** which focus on all that God has promised to do for us in Jesus Christ. It gives us the clearest description of **WHAT IT MEANS TO LIVE BY GOD'S GRACE**.

- I. "GRACE" means that I can always count on God's **power** (vs. 31)
1 John 4:4, 1 John 5:18
- II. "GRACE" means that I can always count on God's **provision** (vs. 32)
Ps. 37:4, Ps. 84:11, Phil. 4:19
- III. "GRACE" means that I can always count on God's **protection** (vs. 33)
Rev. 12:10, 1 John 2:1
- IV. "GRACE" means that I can always count on God's **pardon** (vs. 34)
Rom. 8:1-4, 1 Peter 3:18
- V. "GRACE" means that I can always count on God's **presence** (vs. 35-39)
John 10:28, Heb. 13:5

Because of God's Grace, **5 THINGS** I don't ever have to worry about:

- 1. **opposition** from God
- 2. **situations** from God
- 3. **accusation** from God
- 4. **condemnation** from God
- 5. **separation** from God
