

"Effective Gospel Ministry"

Liberty in Christ Jesus Galatians 2:1-10

A fruitful gospel ministry will:

- I. Consult "communicated unto them that gospel" (vs. 1-2)

 Consult with the:
 - A. Scripture "went up by revelation"
 - **B.** Spiritual -"privately to them which were of reputation"
 - C. Strategy "lest...I should run, or had run, in vain"
- II. Contend -"our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus" (vs. 3-5)

 Contend with those who:
- A. Infiltrate "false brethren unawares brought in" Contend for your Family
- **B.** Indenture "that they might bring us into bondage" Contend for your Freedom
- *C. Impel* "to whom we gave place by subjection, no, not" Contend for your Faith
- III. Cooperate "the right hands of fellowship" (vs. 6-10)

 Cooperate with the true:
 - A. Gospel "when they saw the gospel...was committed"
 - **B.** God "the same was mighty in me towards the Gentiles"
 - C. Grace "perceived the grace that was given unto me"

Sentence Sermon:

"Oftentimes the greatest opposition to the gospel ministry comes from within the church."
