# **INTRODUCTION:** <u>A GLOBAL CALLING TO LOCAL ACTION</u>

- **A. DISTINCTION: REFUGEE VS. IMMIGRANT** (involuntary vs. voluntary; fleeing vs. migrating; emergency vs. urgency; greater need→greater duty (Tt.3:14); see sermon on immigration, 17Oct15)
- **B. LOCAL LEGACY: FT. ONTARIO EMERGENCY REFUGEE SHELTER** (Safe Haven; 1944-45; note: Heb.11:31; *The Hiding Place*, Corrie ten Boom; Raoul Wallenberg, etc.)

#### C. GLOBAL EMERGENCY: LOCAL LEGACY LOST

- 1. refugees from/to the world (e.g., from Africa, Asia, Middle East, CASA / e.g., to W. Europe)
- 2. numerous agencies: governmental, non-governmental, faith-based (e.g., UNHCR, Intnl. Rescue Comm., Samaritans Purse; InterFaith Works of CNY etc.!)
- 3. generally wretched emergency camps due largely to overwhelming need
- 4. too much by too few, too little by too many; extreme reactions political left & right (all/nothing)
- 5. current US: slow, narrowing process of resettlement

## II. <u>THE CHURCH AS A REFUGE FOR ALL WHO COME TO HER</u> (e.g., Shelter RPC

(Vancouver, BC); see Asylum RPC; Rock RPC, etc.)

## A. BIBLICAL EXAMPLES OF REFUGEES

- 1. Adam: fled from the garden into the wilderness (Gen.3:24)
- 2. Noah: fled from the flood into the ark (Gen.7:15)
- 3. Jacob: fled from famine into Egypt (Gen.46:1f)
- 4. Moses: fled from Egypt into the Promised Land (Gen.50:24; Ex.12:25; etc.)
- 5. David: fled from Saul, Absalom into the wilderness (1S.19:10f; 21:10f; Ps.57:1 /2S.15:1f; Ps.3:1)
- 6. Exiles: fled from Assyrians, Babylonians into the nations (Ezk.33:21,22; see Lev.26:33)
- 7. Jesus: fled from Herod into Egypt (Mt.2:13f)
- 8. Christians: fleeing from sin & death to Christ (Ps.2:1f,12; Mt.3:7; 11:28; Jn.6:37; 1C.10:14; 6:18; Rv.21f)
- 9. Summary: the people of God are refugees & God Himself is our refuge

#### **B. BIBLICAL MORAL LOGIC**

- 1. Nation of priests w/cities of refuge (Ex.19:6; Nm.35:1f; Is.42:6; 49:6; 60:3; 61:9 /1Pt.2:9; Mt.25:34f)
- 2. Refugees from injustice vs. fugitives from justice (Num.35:11f,22f/16f; Heb.11:31; note:
  - "sanctuary cities", yet Acts 5:29; Ex.20:1f; e.g., The Hiding Place)
- 3. Summary: give what received (Ex.22:21; 23:9; Lev.19:34; Mt.6:14; 7:12; 25:34f)
