## "Jesus Christ, the Source of Fellowship" 1 John 1:1-4 9/24/20

John had 5 purposes in writing 1 John:

- 1. To Stimulate Fullness of Joy 1:4 (joy is the result of fellowship)
- 2. To Stimulate Resistance of Sin 2:1, 12-14; 3:7-9 (sinning is inconsistent with fellowship)
- 3. To Stimulate Love for One Another 3:11; 4:7, 11, 21 (love is a result of fellowship)
- 4. To Stimulate Awareness of False Teaching 2:18, 26 (false teaching undermines fellowship)
- 5. To Stimulate Assurance of Eternal Life 5:13 (assurance encourages fellowship)
- 1. Fellowship Is Based on a True Message about Christ 1

2. Fellowship Is Based on a Revealed Message about Christ – 2

3. Fellowship Is with Other Believers – 3a

4. Fellowship Is with God the Father and the Son – 3b

5. Fellowship Brings Joy – 4
