The location of the Transfiguration is not known. In the Crusader times Mount Tabor (which happened to be under Crusader control) was identified as a traditional site. Today many scholars believe these events took place on Mount Hermon. Regardless of the details on this day the Apostles “saw his glory” (v 32) alongside Moses and Elijah.
