THE DETERMINATION PRINCIPLE

Psalm 119:10

With my whole heart I have sought You;
Oh, let me not wander from Your commandments!

THE FORTIFICATION PRINCIPLE

Psalm 119:11

Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You.

Philippians 4:8

- 8 Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.

Psalm 119:12

Blessed art thou, O Lord: teach me thy statutes.

THE VERBALIZATION PRINCIPLE

Psalm 119:13

13 With my lips have I declared all the judgments of thy mouth

Revelation 12:11

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death

THE EVALUATION PRINCIPLE

Psalm 119:14

14 I have rejoiced in the way of thy testimonies, <u>as</u> much as in all riches.

Hebrews 11:24-26

- 24 By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter,
- 25 Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;
- 26 Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he looked to the reward.

THE MEDITATION PRINCIPLE


Psalm 119:15-16
