Sodom's Judgment Genesis 19:12-29

Main Point:

Because God takes sin very seriously, judgment is coming and may be here soon; therefore, make sure you're responding rightly to the warning.

1. Through Sodom's destruction, God warns you of His judgment to come.

2. Judgment is coming because God takes sin very seriously.

3. You will only be spared from this judgment if you're righteous in Christ.

4. Make sure you're responding rightly to the warning.
