- I. OVERSEERS: "manages...well" (1 Tim. 3)
 - **A. Authority:** "manages his own household well" (v.4a)
 - **B.** Accountability: "keeping his children" (v.4b)
 - 1. Obedient: "under control"
 - 2. Orderly: "with all dignity"
 - C. Assembly: "if a man does not know how" (v.5)
 - 1. Children: "his own household"
 - 2. Church: "the church of God"

II. OLDER WOMEN: "may encourage" (Tit. 2)

- **A. Maturity:** "Older women...are to be" (v.3)
 - 1. Conduct: "reverent in their behavior"
 - 2. Constraint: "not malicious gossips"
 - 3. Control: "nor enslaved to much wine"
 - 4. Counsel: "teaching what is good"
- **B. Ministry:** "encourage the young women" (vv.4-5a)
 - 1 Devoted: "to love their husbands"
 - 2. Dedicated: "to love their children"
 - 3. Discreet: "to be sensible"
 - 4. Decent: "to be pure"
 - 5. Domestic: "to be workers at home"
 - 6. Dependable: "to be kind"
 - 7. Dutiful: "being subject to their own husbands"
- **C. Motive:** "the word...may not be dishonored" (v.5b)
