Session #19 – The Faithfulness of God.

The Biblical Witness that God is Faithful

What is the greatest display of the faithfulness of God?

The Meaning of Divine Faithfulness

That God is faithful has a variety of implications and expressions, but the fundamental issue with the faithfulness of God is this: He is ______. You can depend upon him. He himself is true.

J. I. Packer contends that "______ in the Bible is a quality of persons primarily, and of propositions only secondarily: it means stability, reliability, firmness, trustworthiness, the quality of a person who is entirely self-consistent, sincere, realistic, and undeceived. God is such a person: truth, in this sense, is his nature, and he has not got it in Him to be anything else" (*Knowing God*, 102).

If God himself is true, then, if he SAYS it, it's true. If he PROMISES it, he will make good on the promise. If he WARNS, he will make good on the threat. If you belong to him, he will not abandon you.

That God is faithful means that He has GOT YOUR BACK ... as well as your front and what is all around you. If he is for you, You can absolutely depend upon him.

That God is faithful means his faithfulness does not depend on yours. He is going to be faithful no matter what you do.

5. He WILL ______ hear the prayer of those who cry out to him! Psalm 34:15 – The eyes of the LORD are toward the righteous and his ears toward their cry.

Persist in prayer because a pause in God's answer is not a failure to answer.
