The "time of visitation" (19:44) has come! The Lord comes suddenly to "<u>his</u> temple" (Mal. 3:1), a worship structure now housing national ponzi schemers – a "den of robbers." Luke's account is condensed, but he carefully records the clash between Jesus and the "chief priests" and Jesus' interpretation of these events. The teaching is that when "God's beloved Son" (20:13) draws near in accountability one's true identity will be revealed. Are they his obedient child or a raging rebel? Will you do your Creator the honor of respecting "my beloved Son" (3:22)?
