TEXT: Acts 17:10 And the brethren immediately sent away **Paul and Silas** by night unto Berea: who coming thither went into the synagogue of the Jews.

11 These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received **the word** with all readiness of mind, and **searched the scriptures** daily, **whether those things were so.**

A letter from Bohemia to the Erasmus about certain Christians (1519):

"These men have no other opinion of the Pope, cardinals, bishops, and other clergy than of manifest Antichrists...Their own bishops and priests, they themselves do choose for themselves, ignorant and unlearned laymen, that have wife and children. They mutually salute one another by the name of brother and sister. **They own no other authority than the Scriptures of the Old and New Testament.** They slight **all the doctors, both ancient and modern**, and give no regard to their doctrine...Such as come over to their sect, must every one be baptized anew in mere water. They believe nothing of divinity in the sacrament of the eucharist...and, accordingly, that all that do knee down to it, or worship, are guilty of idolatry; that that sacrament was instituted by Christ to no other purpose but to renew the memory of his passion, and not to be carried about or held up by the priests to be gazed on...Prayers to saints, and for the dead, they count a vain and ridiculous thing...Eves and fast-days are, they say, a mockery and disguise of hypocrites..." (Joannes Slechta Costelecius, Oct. 10, 1519)

Church Progress' Tenth Affirmative (July 4, 1891):
