## "Elijah- Prayer That Brings Victory!" Sept. 29, 2013

## Scripture Reading - I Kings 18:17-24, 36-39

- 1. The Pre-Fight "Trash-Talk." (18:17-18)
- 2. The "Mt. Carmel" Challenge. (18:19-20)

"How long will you go limping between two different opinions? If the LORD is God –Follow Him!" (18:21)

- **3.** The <u>Rules</u> of the Fight.
  - Elijah vs. 450 Baal prophets (plus 400 Asherah prophets)
  - The LORD vs. Baal
  - Two bulls, Two prayers –no fire.
  - If fire comes due to prayer, then all will know who is God.
- 4. The "Fight."
  - The Baal prophets prayed! (NO FIRE!)
    - 1. Wrong object of their prayer.
    - 2. Lots of time.
    - 3. Human effort and self-mutilation.
  - Elijah prayed! (FIRE!)
    - 1. The <u>altar</u> prepared.
    - 2. The added water.
    - 3. The purpose of the prayer –"The LORD is God!"

## **Application:**

- 1. Do we tend to be "lukewarm" in our faith? What areas do we hesitate to fully follow the LORD?
- 2. If the LORD is God (and He is) how should that change our prayers?
- 3. Discuss the difference between the approach to prayer as you compare Elijah and the false prophets.
- 4. What kind of victory can we claim in our prayer life today?
