Application Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read **Acts 9:15**. Knowing something of Saul/Paul's background (cf. vv.4-5) imagine what a jarring revelation this description of his calling must have been to everyone. What aspects of your calling (at work, home, or church) tend to give rise to feelings of being personally inadequate, incapable, or underclubbed?
- 2. Read **2 Corinthians 2:14 3:5**. Describe the associated dangers of not finding this proper balance regarding "confidence" and "sufficiency." In other words, what happens when you fail to have the confidence of 3:4 or, on the other hand, you fail to keep in mind your personal insufficiency (2:16b, 3:5a)?
- 3. Read **Judges 6:11-16** & **7:2**. What are some of the things with which God has blessed you, that can become something you wrongly credit for your successes?
- 4. Read **Psalm 33:16-22** and **Jeremiah 9:23-24**. How does one practically keep this mindset, especially when blessed with many temporal resources and provisions?
- 5. Read **Habakkuk 3:17-19**. When you experience setbacks or defeats in your work, your home, or your ministry, what are some of the things that must be remembered to actually follow Habakkuk's example in these verses?
