This evening we come to pray that the kingdom would advance. First in our own hearts and then in others, and that Christ would hasten the day when the kingdom of grace will blossom into the kingdom of glory.

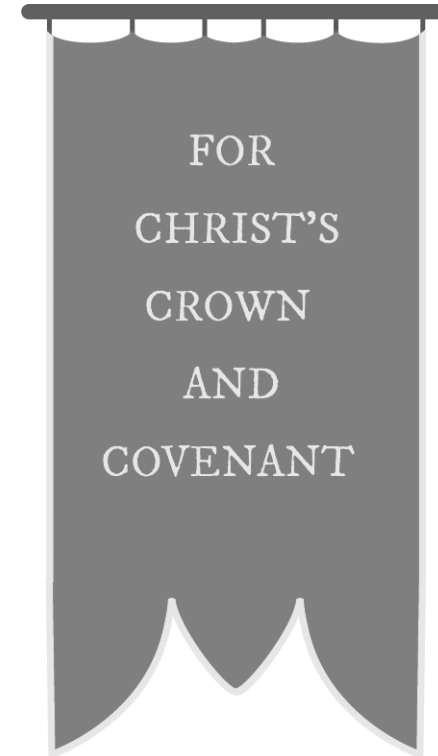
Pray...

- That the kingdom of grace (Matthew 28:18-20) would advance through Christ’s exercise of His kingdom of power (Isaiah 64:1).
- That the name of the Lord would be glorified and praised throughout the earth (Psalm 67, Psalm 83) by the work of Jesus Christ conquering hearts (Rev. 6:2)
- That the Lord would reign in our own hearts (Eph. 3:14) as well as convert the hearts of those who do not yet bow down to Him.
- That the Lord would supply all that the Church needs to fulfill the Great Commission. Including having the necessary gospel officers (Matthew 9:38).
- That the Lord would come quickly (Rev. 22:20).
- For the Lord to heal the nation’s deep divisions through a revival of faith in Jesus Christ (Galatians 3:28).
- For protection for the magistrates and police who are trying to keep order against growing lawlessness (Romans 13:4-5), and that justice would prevail in those areas where there are injustices in our nation (Psalm 33:5).
- For protection from the Coronavirus (Psalm 91:3), and that it would abate.
- For a competent portion of those things we need in this life (Matthew 6:11), including food, work, and covering.
- For the Lord to raise up ministers of the gospel to go into the harvest (Matthew 9:38).
- Pray that the Lord would preserve our congregation’s lampstand (Rev 2:5) and witness to McKinney.
- Pray for the church as she is persecuted and that she would have a godly witness (Matthew 5:10). Pray that the church in our nation would not be persecuted so we could live godly lives (1 Timothy 2:2).
- Pray for the increase of Christ’s Kingdom over the earth (Matthew 6:10).
- Pray for our congregation, that we would walk as befitting the sons and daughters of light (Ephesians 5:8), that the world would perceive us as His children and give glory to God.
- Pray for our families, that the Lord would preserve our families and call all of the covenant children to Himself (Acts 2:38), that they would not depart from the way in which they should go (Proverbs 22:6), and provide godly spouses for them.
- Thank Christ for His great care for us (Luke 22:40, 45) and for fulfilling all righteousness (Matthew 3:15) on our behalf.

Please continue to pray over these things through the week as a guide for your own personal and family prayers.

### **LARGER CATECHISM Q. 191.** *What do we pray for in the second petition?*

*A.* In the second petition, (which is, *Thy kingdom come*;) acknowledging ourselves and all mankind to be by nature under the dominion of sin and Satan, we pray, that the kingdom of sin and Satan may be destroyed, the gospel propagated throughout the world, the Jews called, the fulness of the Gentiles brought in; the church furnished with all gospel officers and ordinances, purged from corruption, countenanced and maintained by the civil magistrate: that the ordinances of Christ may be purely dispensed, and made effectual to the converting of those that are yet in their sins, and the confirming, comforting, and building up of those that are already converted: that Christ would rule in our hearts here, and hasten the time of his second coming, and our reigning with him for ever: and that he would be pleased so to exercise the kingdom of his power in all the world, as may best conduce to these ends.

### **HEIDELBERG CATECHISM Q. 123.** *What is the second petition?*

*A.* That is: So govern us by Thy word and Spirit, that we *submit* ourselves unto Thee always more and more; preserve and increase *Thy Church*; destroy the works of the devil, every power that exalteth itself against Thee, and all wicked devices formed against Thy holy word, until the *full coming* of *Thy kingdom*, wherein Thou shalt be all in all.
