- I. The High Priest
  - A. Set apart by God
  - B. Chief work: Day of Atonement
- II. The Short-Comings of the Earthly High Priest (5:1-4)
  - A. Called by God, but eventually political appointed by “the power of the family”
  - B. Weak as any other man
  - C. Sacrifice for own sins before the sins of others
- III. Jesus: A Better High Priest
  - A. Like us, but without sin (Incarnation)
  - B. Made glorious by God
  - C. Made glorious through suffering
  - D. Source of eternal salvation
  - E. A “kingly priesthood”
- IV. Let Us Draw Near
  - A. Our confidence is to be in Jesus
  - B. Our confidence is not in tradition, heritage, or accomplishment
  - C. What confidence do we have that we view as better than Jesus?
