15 Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child; the rod of correction will drive it far from him.

Psalms 14:1

14 The fool has said in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, They have done abominable works, There is none who does good.

15 The rod and rebuke give wisdom, but a child left to himself brings shame to his mother.

1 Corinthians 2:14

Proverbs 22:6

6 Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it.

17 Brethren, join in following my example, and note those who so walk, as you have us for a pattern.

2 Peter 2:13-14

13 and will receive the wages of unrighteousness, as those who count it pleasure to carouse in the daytime. They are spots and blemishes, carousing in their own deceptions while they feast with you, 14 having eyes full of adultery and that cannot cease from sin, enticing unstable souls.
