INTRODUCTION

- amazing, unimaginable transformations

1. The new life God provides

- the spiritually dead brought to life

Eph. 2:1

Jn. 3:19-20

Rom. 1:16

- abandoning and abandoned by the world

Mt. 5:11-12

2. The new life God protects

- visible care superseded by invisible care

Is. 46:6; Phil. 1:6

- the fullness of God’s protection brings joy

Jn. 15:11; 16:20-22

- the focus of God’s protection from evil and the evil one

Mt. 6:13

Jn. 12:31; 14:30; 16:11

1 Jn. 5:18-19

3. The new life God propagates

- “sanctify”

+ fundamentally, holiness describes the nature of God

Jn. 17:11; Is. 6:3

+ derivatively, holiness belongs to all given/dedicated to God

Jer. 1:5; Ex. 28:2-4

- sanctified morally: called unto purity

2 Cor. 7:1; 1 Thess 4:3-5; Rom. 12:1-2

- sanctified missionally: called unto propagation

2 Cor. 5:20
