- God Requires That His Children Live In The Unvielding Power Of Grace, (vs. 3 8)
  - o For By The Power Of God's Grace We Live In True Unity, (vs. 3 5)
    - We live under the authority of God's grace, (vs. 3a)
    - "Given," (Aor.Pas.Part)
    - "Among," (Pres.Act.Part)
    - "But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace toward me was not in vain. On the contrary, I worked harder than any of them, though it was not I, but the grace of God that is with me." (1 Corinthians 15:10)
      - ♣ God's grace requires us to remember our modest state, (vs. 3b)
        - \* "The Pharisee, standing by himself, <u>prayed</u> thus: 'God, I thank you that I am not like other men, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week; I give tithes of all that I get.'" (Luke 18:11-12)
      - ♣ God's grace requires us to exercise sober judgment, (vs. 3c)
        - \* "For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works. Declare these things; exhort and rebuke with all authority. Let no one disregard you." (Titus 2:11-15)
        - \* "I desire then that in every place the men should pray, lifting holy hands without anger or quarreling; likewise also that women should adorn themselves in respectable apparel, with modesty and self-control, not with braided hair and gold or pearls or costly attire, but with what is proper for women who profess godliness—with good works. Let a woman learn quietly with all submissiveness. I do not permit a woman to teach or to exercise authority over a man; rather, she is to remain quiet." (1 Timothy 2:8-12)
