## INTRODUCTION:

- 1. The Jews proved their hypocrisy again by demanding that the crucified bodies be taken down before the Sabbath (Joh 19:31-37).
  - a. The soldiers discovered that Jesus was dead (Joh 19:32-33).
  - b. One soldier made sure that Jesus was dead (Joh 19:34).
  - c. All this fulfilled prophetic Scripture (Joh 19:35-37)
- 2. JOSEPH OF ARIMATHAEA BEGGED PILATE FOR JESUS' BODY (27:57-58).
  - a. Who was Joseph of Arimathaea?
  - b. Pilate yielded to Joseph's plea (27:57-58).
- 3. APPLICATIONS:

- (1) We as Christ's disciples must learn that what sometimes looks like failure can be used for great good in God's sovereign hands.
- (2) We as Christ's disciples must learn that Jesus often has disciples in the most unlikely places—even in the camp of our enemies.
- (3) We as Christ's disciples must learn that following Christ is risky and sometimes fraught with danger.
- (4) We as Christ's disciples must learn to rest entirely upon the truth and authority of God's infallible and prophetic Word.
- (5) To unbelievers, I make this application: on the cross of Calvary, a fountain for sin and uncleanness was opened—flee to it!
