The Greatness of God, 1

- What names tell us
- Hebrew names reveal information about the person, Exodus 34.5-7
- Hallowed be thy name
- LORD- Yahweh, God's covenant name
- Lord- Sovereign ruler/master
- Hebrew superstition
- David: God's name is for all the earth

Greatness of God's Universe, 1b-3

- God's glory
 - o The heavens, moon and stars
 - Work of his fingers
 - The glory of his creation: Grand Canyon
 - Theodore Roosevelt and William Beebe: "Sufficiently small"
- Vance Havner: a sad day when ceilings were created
- I Kings 8.27
- The privilege of praise
- Jesus quotes this, Matthew 21.15-16

The Greatness of the Image Bearers of God, 4-8

- What are humans that God thinks about us and cares for us?
 - We will never understand humans unless we see them as God's creatures with special responsibilities
 - Harvard gate inscription
- We are a little lower than angels...
 - Note he did not say we are a little higher than animals.
- We are made in God's image
 - o We have dominion over the animals- not equality with
 - o Mediocre?

Reaffirmed: The Greatness of God, 9

- The impact of a high view of humanity
- We have astonishing dignity because we are made in the image of Christ.
- Jesus shows us the potential of humanity, Hebrews 2.5-9

• He suffered for us so that he might take our death penalty and give us life
