"That You May Live" Deuteronomy 4: 1 - 14 May 30, 2010

• God Has Told Us What Is Necessary To Live In Abundance, (vs. 1 - 14)

Listening To My Word Is Commanded, Not Suggested Amending My Word Is Not Allowed

- o God Says, Following My Word Is Something I Take VERY Seriously, (vs. 3 4)
 - ♣ Seriously, God is open & forthright about how He operates, (vs. 3a)
 - And God SPOKE all these words, saying, "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.
 - YOU SHALL HAVE no other gods before me. "You shall not MAKE for yourself a carved image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.
 - You shall not Bow down to them or SERVE them, for I the Lord your God am a jealous God,
 - ✓ visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and the fourth generation of those who hate me,
 - ✓ but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments." (Exodus 20:1-6)
 - ✓ "The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned. The spiritual person judges all things, but is himself to be judged by no one. "For who has understood the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?" But we have the mind of Christ." (1 Corinthians 2:14-16)
 - Seriously, God has demonstrated a history of fierce anger against disobedience, (vs. 3b)
 - Disobedience is not actions, it is who you are; "... the people BEGAN to whore with the daughters of Moab.
 - These **INVITED** the people to the sacrifices of their gods,
 - and the people ATE and BOWED down to their gods.
 - So Israel **YOKED** himself to Baal of Peor.
 - Living in disobedience will bring God's anger; And the anger of the Lord was KINDLED against Israel.
 - And the Lord SAID to Moses, "TAKE all the chiefs of the people and HANG them in the sun before the Lord, that the fierce anger of the Lord may turn away from Israel."
 - > And Moses SAID to the judges of Israel, "Each of you KILL those of his men who have yoked themselves to Baal of Peor."
 - Disobedience willfully spurns God's anger; And behold, one of the people of Israel CAME and BROUGHT a Midianite woman to his family,
 - in the sight of Moses and in the sight of the whole congregation of the people of Israel,
 - *while they were weeping in the entrance of the tent of meeting.*
 - Disobedience must be dealt with radically; When Phinehas the son of Eleazar, son of Aaron the priest, SAW it, he ROSE and left the congregation and TOOK a spear in his hand and WENT after the man of Israel into the chamber and PIERCED both of them, the man of Israel and the woman through her belly.
 - ❖ <u>Disobedience</u> will bring real consequences; Thus the plague on the people of Israel was STOPPED. Nevertheless, those who died by the plague <u>WERE</u> twenty-four thousand." (Numbers 25:1-9)
 - * "What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; as God said, "I will make my dwelling among them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

 Therefore go out from their midst, and be separate from them, says the Lord, and touch no unclean thing; then I will welcome you," (2 Corinthians 6:16-17)
 - ♣ Seriously, clinging to God is the only way to survive, (vs. 4)
 - * "Then they LIFTED up their voices and WEPT again. And Orpah KISSED her mother-in-law, but Ruth CLUNG to her.
 - And she SAID, "See, your sister-in-law has GONE back to her people and to her gods; RETURN after your sister-in-law."
 - ❖ But Ruth SAID, "Do not urge me to leave you or to return from following you.
 - For where you GO I will GO, and where you LODGE I will LODGE.
 - Your people shall be my people, and your God my God.
 - Where you DIE I will DIE, and there will I be BURIED.
 - May the Lord do so to me and more also if anything but death PARTS me from you.
 - > And when Naomi saw that she was DETERMINED to go with her, SHE SAID NO MORE." (Ruth 1:14-18)
 - "... he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw <u>near</u> to God through him, since he always <u>lives</u> to make intercession for them." (Hebrews 7:25)
