  - B. Genuine righteousness trusts in God's promise of provision, (vs. 7 11)
    - God charges the believer to be diligent in seeking provision, (vs. 7 8); "Seek the LORD while he may be found; call upon him while he is near; ""let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the LORD, that he may have compassion on him, and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon." (Isaiah 55:6–7 ESV)

• God promises to give to those who diligently ask, (vs. 9 – 11); "Who is a God like you, pardoning iniquity and passing over transgression for the remnant of his inheritance? He does not retain his anger forever, because he delights in steadfast love." (Micah 7:18 ESV)

- C. Genuine righteousness travels through the narrow way of God's instruction, (vs. 12 14)
- D. Genuine righteousness produces the good fruit of God's glory, (vs. 13 20)
- E. Genuine righteousness obeys the will of God, (vs. 14 23)
