Lesson 6: Jonah, Repossession, & Jesus' Family

Matthew 12:38-50

- I. THE SIGN OF JONAH (38-42) The Resurrection of Christ
 - A. Demanding a Sign (38-39; Jud 6:17; Isa 7:11; Isa 38:7-8)—putting God to the test
 - 1. Insolent-inappropriate boldness, aggressive rudeness, disrespect
 - **2. Unreasonable**—How many signs do they need?
 - **3.** <u>Insincere</u>—looking for an excuse to <u>not</u> believe
 - **B. Shaming the Wise** (41-42; 1 Cor 1:27-28)
 - 1. Their faith is inferior to a Gentile's. This is a calculated insult.
 - 2. They have missed the point of Scripture (Lk 24:25-27) It is all about Jesus.
 - **C.** Recognizing Something Greater (41-42)
 - 1. <u>Jonah</u>—prophet, reluctant preacher of repentance
 - 2. Solomon—king of Israel's Golden Age, wisest teacher on earth
 - **D.** <u>The Ultimate Evidence: The Resurrection of Christ</u> (40; Rom 1:3-4; 1 Cor 15:14) The ultimate proof that He is the divine Son of God and Savior of the World

- **II.** THE RETURN OF AN UNCLEAN SPIRIT (43-45; 2 Pet 2:20-22)—warning of the consequences of rejecting Christ after having benefitted from His ministry.
 - A. A Spiritual Parasite—needs a human host for a home
 - B. <u>A Spiritual Vacuum</u>—individuals and culture
 - 1. The authority of Christ casts out evil.
 - **2.** The presence of Christ keeps out evil. Demons are squatters.
 - C. Worse than Before (2 Pet 20-22)—evil returns with a vengeance
 - 1. Rejection of Christ is worse than ignorance.
 - 2. Neglect of grace invites reinvasion.
- III. THE MOTHER AND BROTHERS OF JESUS (46-50)
 - A. Family Interference—don't be a stumbling block to a family member in ministry!
 - **B.** Family Privilege
 - 1. God's family outranks human family.
 - 2. Everyone in God's family has equal access to Jesus.
 - a. We are related to <u>Jesus</u>.
 - b. We are related to one another.
