



#### Chronological Timeline of Revelation

#### Why is this section here?

Heb 10:23-25 Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;) <sup>24</sup> And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: <sup>25</sup> Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

#### Why is this section here?

- → Written to seven historical, geographical local churches
  - → To encourage faithful service to Him
    - Distinguishes between "what is" and "what will be"

Rev 1:19 Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter

#### Who is this section written to?

→ Actual historical churches with real problems

Any church today who can identify with these historical churches and their problems "Those who cannot remember the past are condemned to repeat it" ~~ Author unknown

#### The Apostle Paul's commendation

Eph 1:15 Wherefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints

"thou has left thy first love"

Their service had become rote and mechanical Loss of love and devotion to the Lord

Repent

Remember

Return

God is less concerned about our outward show than He is about our devotion to Him

- Be in the paradise of God

### The Lord's commendation

✓ Endured persecution

✓ Endured poverty

### The Lord's rebuke

#### None!

Mat 25:23 Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

Smyrna's sufferings, though extremely difficult, had helped keep them pure in faith and life.

1Pe 1:7 That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ

#### The Lord's exhortation

 $\rightarrow$  Do not fear

2Ti 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

#### → Be faithful unto death

Luk 1:26 If any man come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple.
