GOD'S MESSAGE TO THE SEVEN CHURCHES

#### Key verse for this section

Heb 10:23-25 Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;) <sup>24</sup> And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: <sup>25</sup> Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

"he which hath the sharp sword with two edges"

The sword symbolizes the Word of God's ability to:

- 1. Separate believers from the world
- 2. Condemn the world of sin

Pergamos was a wicked city with rampant idol worship; adverse to any effective Christian life and testimony

Christ's Commendation

→ Held fast to His name

#### Christ's Rebuke

Tolerated the doctrine of Balaam
 Lack of separation – Intermarriage with heathen – Adopting worldly ways – Idol worship

"We cannot become friends with the world and expect to remain separate. We will become like them"

Christ's Rebuke

#### 2. Tolerated the doctrine of Nicolaitans Grace without obedience

Rom 6:15 What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid.

#### Christ's Promise

 Overcomers will eat of the hidden manna A possible reference to Jesus Himself

Jhn 6:35 I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger

#### Christ's Promise

2. To receive a stone with a new name

The old man does not enter into the kingdom of God

2Co 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

The reference to His eyes being "like blazing fire" and the brilliant reflections of His feet emphasize the indignation and righteous judgment of Christ.

Christ's Commendation

→ Charity → Faith

→ Service → Perseverance

...their works tended toward a deeper devotion to Christ...

#### Tolerating Jezebel

- → She promoted fornication and idol worship
- → Her presence affected the testimony of the church

Gal 5:9 A little leaven leaveneth the whole lump.

"God is patient and longsuffering, but even those traits of God have their limitations"

#### REPENT

or else face the judgment of God Christ will not tolerate flagrant and rebellious sin in His church

For the godly remnant to remain FAITHFUL (a recurring theme throughout Revelation)
