Expect to Be Surprised

Matthew 24:36-51

- I. THE DAYS OF NOAH (37-39; Lk 21:34)—Surprised and Unprepared
 - **A.** Eating and Drinking (Phil 3:19; 1 Cor 10:31; Heb 12:16)—physical appetite eclipsing spiritual concerns
 - 1. Worrying about Daily Bread (Mat 6:31-32)—preoccupied with food for survival
 - **2. Obsessed with Epicurean Gluttony** (Lk 12:19-20)—pursuing food as highest good/pleasure
 - B. Marrying and Giving in Marriage ()—building our own kingdoms
 - 1. Family Matters—making home, pleasing parents, producing children
 - 2. Social Expectations—establishing and advancing my place in the world
 - C. <u>Preoccupied with This World</u> (Phil 3:19)—worldly life as usual, no thought for coming judgment
 - **1. Feed Your Soul.** (Isa 55:1-3; Mat 4:4; Jn 4:13-14, 32-34)
 - **2.** Devote yourself to building <u>God's</u> kingdom. (Mat 6:33 & 19:12; 1 Cor 7:7, 29-38; Heb 13:4)
- II. TWO MEN IN THE FIELD (40-41)—God Knows Who
 - **A.** <u>Close Association</u>—coworkers, neighbors, friends, family members
 - B. Normal Activities (Jn 17: 15-16)—working, earning wages, homemaking, preparing food
 - C. Final Separation (Ps 1:5-6; 2 Pet 2:9)—those who belong to Jesus and those who don't
- III. A BURGLAR'S BREAK-IN (42-44; Prov 25:28; Joel 2:11-13)—God Knows When
 - A. Real Danger—the eternal destiny of your soul is at stake
 - B. Be Prepared—take thought to protect your soul

IV. THE MASTER'S RETURN (45-51)—Be Faithful

- A. The Absence of the Master—what to make of the delayed return of Christ
 - 1. Jesus is the Master of the Church.
 - 2. We are all servants in His Household.
 - 3. We are to manage His business until He returns.
- B. The Behavior of the Servants—what we're supposed to be doing
 - 1. The Good Servant (45-47)
 - a. Faithful—conducting the master's business with integrity, doing his job
 - **b. Wise**—understands his place, does what is right, and does his job well
 - 2. The Wicked Servant (48-51)—selfish and unfaithful
 - a. Abuse of Authority—self-serving, mistreating the other servants
 - **b. Misuse of Resources**—embezzling the master's property and finances
 - **c.** Irresponsible Behavior (Prov 31:4-5)—intoxicated, neglecting his duties
- C. The Master's Return (2 Pet 3:3-7)—what we're waiting for
 - 1. Jesus will return.
 - 2. Each of us will be called to account.
 - 3. There will be consequences.
 - **a. Reward for the faithful** (46; 2 Tim 4:8)—promotion
 - **b.** Punishment for the unfaithful (51)—death/destruction
- V. WHY THE BIG SECRET? (36)
 - **A. To Reveal Our Character**—Is our love real or are we self-serving?
 - **B.** To Teach Us to Trust Him—We desire to *control*, rely on our wisdom and strength.
 - **C.** To Keep Us from Procrastinating—*Right now* is important.
